

## **HOW TO BE AN ICE MONITOR**

- Ice monitoring is a great volunteer activity with a little bonus for club members only:
  - For any session that you volunteer to be ice monitor, the session(s) for your skater is (are) free. However, you must be fully committed to the task even if that means you don't get to watch your skater during that session(s).
  - Responsibilities include:
    - Checking in skaters to see if they are pre-registered or walk-on
    - Collecting walk-on fees
    - Making sure that only those skaters who have paid for sessions are skating
    - Playing program music in an organized fashion
    - Providing club information to anyone requesting it
    - Making sure any pro who teaching on club ice is registered with the club
    - Obtain another volunteer if you are unable to make your time
  - To get your credit when you volunteer, simply note that you were the volunteer next to your skater's name
    - For pre-registered skaters, you will be given a credit
    - For planned walk-on's you note "Paid thru volunteering" next to your skater's name.
    - Credit is non-transferrable and can only be applied to the current session for which you monitor.
